Exporting from other databases

It is possible to download records to DiVA from other databases.

Below you will find examples of how to download records from PubMed, Scopus and IEEE Xplore. In many other databases the export function is called *Export*, *Download*, *Send* or similar. Export to the BibTeX format often possible. See the section on IEEE for further instructions.

PubMed

Find the records to be downloaded. Tick them in the result list.

IEEE Xplore

Find the records to be downloaded. Tick them in the result list.
